GENERAL INFORMATION

The registration of entries is done online.

New riders need to register online at www.youthstream.org/riderloginrequests.aspx. Usually they will receive a mail with further information within the next 48 hours.

Riders who already registered in the past can start the entry process directly at www.youthstream.org/entry/entryform1.aspx.

IMPORTANT: All riders need to register their personal email address as this is used for the login.

In case of any problems or questions they contact YouthStream by email (sportoffice@youthstream.org).

As soon as the entry request is submitted, an automated mail will be sent to the rider's FMN to obtain the online starting authorisation and any necessary information.

The closing date for entries for the first meeting of the 2016 FIM MXGP/MX2/Women's Motocross World Championship is 60 days before the meeting.

As of the second meeting of the FIM Motocross World Championship, the closing date for entries is 15 days before each meeting MXGP/MX2/Women's/Veterans Motocross World Championship.

Whenever a FIM MXGP/MX2/Women's/Veterans Motocross World Championship Grand Prix is being organised under its aegis, the FMNR may enter two riders in each class. The FMNR must then inform YouthStream, at the latest 15 days before the closing date of entries of the meeting, of the names of the two riders the FMNR wishes to nominate.

CHAMPIONSHIP'S LOGOS

Riders must display the new FIM Championship logo on the upper front torso or shoulder area of their jersey or on their chest/back protector if the latter is worn over the jersey. (Logo: length 70 mm x width 35 mm, see next page for information).

The FIM Championship logo must also be displayed on the front number plate and the lateral number plates.
