1.ANNOUNCEMENT

AMK Český Ráj in ACCR organizes a national event Vintage, Club sports and sidecars – regularity. Event will be counted into ACCR Road Racing Regularity Championship. Point will be given only to ACCR licence holders.

3. CIRCUIT

Length: 3 300 m Width: 4 - 12 m

Maximum difference in altitude: 3 m

Character of the circuit: temporary circuit, partly urban, partly 1st class road with 3 right curves, straight roads divided by three retarders.

Pit lane is situated on the car park SÚS in the area behind the start, visibly separated. The number of people at the Pit lane can be limited by the organizers. A plan of the circuit is enclosed.

4. JURISDICTION

The event will be held in accordance with the ACCR Sporting code, ACCR Road racing rules and these supplementary regulations.

6. CATEGORIES AND CLASSES

Riders can use elliptical shaped plates in size 285 x 235 mm to label the bike. Size of numbers: height 140mm, width 80mm according to the ACCR rules. Letter marking the category can be half size of the number but the same colour.

Coloured marking of the plates and numbers:

For the categories F,H,J,K,L,R,S,T,U,V,W,X,O is the colour of the plate given by the engine capacity.

The sport event is open to all riders with appropriate licence type A, B and Vintage. Acceptable is also licence type H for regularity for holders of DMSB licence. Foreigner riders must submit Start permission issued by their FMN. At the sport event can start only

original racing and super sports motorcycles and sidecars manufactured until the year 1978. All number plates and numbers must be supplied by competitors. Riders use their permanent numbers. In case more riders require the same number organizer decides. Points to the Championship of the Czech Republic Classic can get only holders of the ACCR licence.

7. NUMBER OF RIDES ALLOWED

The maximum number of riders allowed for solo category is following:

Race 30 riders Practice 34 riders

The maximum number of sidecars allowed is following:

Race 20 sidecars Practice 22 sidecars

In case of small number of riders in certain category organizers reserve the right to unite these classes if possible, however the ceremony would be for each class.

8. ENTRY FORMS, ENTRY FEE

Entry forms received after the deadline, June 9th, may not be accepted. By sending the entry form rider is obliged to follow the Supplementary regulations and in case of need any changes that organizers are forced to undergo. 9. ADMINISTRATIVE AND TECHNICAL INSPECTION

Any rider or motorcycle must not enter the circuit until the rider went through the administrative and technical inspection that will be according to the following schedule:

Administrative inspection in the area of paddock:

Friday 28th June 2013 from 12.00 to 19.00 Saturday 29th June 2013 from 7.00 to 8.30

Technical inspection in the area of paddock – all categories:

Friday 28th June 2013 from 13.00 to 20.00 Saturday 29th June 2013 from 7.00 to 9.00

All riders must be in the paddock on Saturday, June 29th 2013 by 8:00am at the latest! The circuit will be closed at 8:00am and the entrance to the paddock will not be possible then. Each rider or passenger comes to the technical inspection with the given approved equipment, confirmed entry form, licence (foreigners Start permission) and technical documentation. In case of accident the technical inspection must be repeated.

10. PRACTICE

It's strictly forbidden to ride a motorcycle on the circuit outside the official practice time! Practices will be according to the following schedule:

The schedule is preliminary and it can be in case of need changed.

Rider must complete a total of at least 3 laps during the qualifying practices to be classified for the race. In case of start in more categories, rider must complete at least 4 laps from all practices where starts. Pole position is given by the organizers.

11. TIME SCHEDULE - RACE

Sunday 30th June 2013

Start is by pushing the bike with stopped engines (it's forbidden to use electric starter) by Starter sign. Rider who is not able to push the bike itself, can be pushed by the assistant. It is necessary to inform Clerk of the Course or Chief Technical Steward after the practices at the

latest. Rider starts from the back row in that case. Rider must wait for the sign of the starter's assistant and start at the time riders who start by their own leave the grid. Rider has 20 seconds to start the machine and if not it's necessary to leave the track.

Jump start is penalized by 60 penalty points. In case of bad weather (for safety reasons) riders will start gradually in agreed intervals. After finishing the first lap, timekeepers measure time of the other given laps. Measured laps are set before the race and only Clerk of the Course, Chief Technical Steward and Chief Timekeeper know that. Measured times are compared with the basic time of the second lap. Time differences from the basic time of 0,01 second are converted to points. Points are added up to set up the final score. The final sequence is given by the total number of penalty points. Time differences of 0,01 second will be used in case of same penalty points.

12. PRIZES

Riders finishing at first, second and third place in each race will be required to take part in a short ceremony. Ceremony will be held during the main pause for the morning races and immediately after the last race for the afternoon races. Prizes will be given during the ceremony. Riders will hear the club's anthem and also the national anthem of the winner.

13. PROTESTS

All protests must be made in accordance with the ACCR Disciplinary Code and accompanied by a fee of 5 000,- CZK / 200 €.

14. FUEL

Used fuel must be in accordance with article 2.10 of the FIM Technical Rules for road racing motorcycles. In case the motorcycle has in its documentation any other fuel required (Methanol), rider will use the fuel that is specified in the technical card. Organizers do not provide the fuel. Petrol station is opposite the exit from the paddock.

15. DRUG AND ALCOHOL TESTING

There will be random tests for alcohol and presence of narcotics during the sport event.

16. INSURANCE

In accordance with the article 110.1 of the Sporting Code ACCR, the organizer's liability insurance and responsibility of riders, passengers, competitors and officials, in case of an accident caused to the third party during the whole sport event is in the responsibility of the organizers.

The organizer is obliged to arrange an insurance of participants for damage caused by his motorcycle during the sport event. The payment of this insurance is included in the entry fee. The number of the insurance contract: 0013869817 – through the insurance brokerage company RENOMIA a.s.

The organizer disclaims all responsibility for damage to motorcycle, its accessories and components arising out of an accident, fire or other cases.

By confirming entry form the FMN of the rider (passenger) certifies that the rider (passenger) is insured in accordance to FIM Europe requirements.

17. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

Apart from the requirements of the ACCR Sporting Code, participants (incl., but not only: competitors, riders, mechanics, guests etc.) by participating renounce all rights of appeal against the organizer, his representatives or agents by arbitration of before a tribunal or any other manner not foreseen by the ACCR Sporting Code for any damages for which they could be liable in consequence of all acts or omissions on the part of organizer, his officials, representatives or agents in the application of these regulations or contributed to or arising out their actions.

The management of the race and Jury reserves the right to modify these Supplementary regulations and the timetable of the event by bulletins published later.

18. PARKING AND THE EXIT FROM THE TRACK

Paddock is a part of the accommodation facilities camp Rumcajs. Area of the paddock is fenced and at the time of the event closed for the public. Riders (passengers) and members of their team are obliged to follow the organizer's instructions. Riders will ride to the starting line through the access road from the paddock. Return to the paddock is through the lower gate - side entrance to the camp Rumcajs. Rider will slowly pass one more lap after the race and will be diverted to the previously mentioned side entrance.
