As the Entry Form from the Driver and the Confirmation of the acceptance from the Organiser is considered as a contract, the Driver, not coming to the Event, has to apologise giving the reason as soon as possible. The Entry Fee will be paid at the Administrative checking.

6.6 Acceptance of entries will be decided by the organiser.

The maximum total number of starters will be 70.

The maximum total number of starters for the support race will be 35.

7. ENTRY FEES

- **7.2.** Entry fee will be collected on the administrative checking.
- 7.3. An additional fee of € 250,- must be paid by a competitor who refuses to carry the organisers sponsors advertising on his car.

8. INSURANCE

8.1 Insurance coverage of the organiser

The Autoklub CR concluded with "Ceska podnikatelska pojistovna, a.s." – Vienna Insurance Group, through the company RENOMIA, a.s., the frame insurance contract No. 0013869817on insurance of liability of the organiser for damage caused to the others in connection with a sport enterprise up to the sum of CZK 5.000.000.

8.2 Insurance of competitors and crews

- 8.2.1 The frame insurance contract No. 0013869817 concluded by and between the "Ceska podnikatelska pojistovna, a.s." Vienna Insurance Group and Autoklub CR includes insurance of cars of the participants against damages caused to third persons up to the sum of CZK 3.000.000 per one insurance event with co-participation of CZK 5.000. Any damage below CZK 5.000 will be paid by the driver who caused the damage; damages above CZK 5.000 will be paid by the insurance company without any co-participation of the insured. However the insurance does not cover liability for the damages caused by event participant that the competitors cause each other in the course of sport event.
- 8.2.2 Each driver is obliged to conclude his personal injury insurance and to present a proof on request the administrative checking. The insurance of foreign drivers must include coverage of costs for possible medical treatment in the CR.

9. AMENDMENTS - INTERPRETATION

- 9.1 In accordance with Article 66 of the Code, no alterations shall be made to these regulations after the beginning of the period for receiving entries, unless unanimous agreement is given by all competitors already entered, or by decision of the stewards of the meeting for reasons of "force majeure" or safety.
- 9.2 Any information will be announced by dated and numbered information bulletins which will be an integral part of these regulations. These bulletins will be posted at the official notice board at the entrance to paddock and/or will be directly communicated to the competitors.
- 9.3 Any bulletin concerning sporting matters must be, before publishing, signed by the stewards of the meeting.
- 9.4 The stewards of the meeting are empowered to take a decision on any case not covered by these regulations.
- 9.5 In the case of differences of interpretation as regards the terms used in these regulations, only the English text will be considered as authentic.

IV. CHECKING

11. SCRUTINEERING

11.3 Noise: For all cars, a limit of 100 dB is imposed.

11.4 Competition numbers

- **11.4.1** The entrant will provide his car with competition numbers, which must be affixed to his car in the positions stated below prior to scrutineering:
- **11.4.2 MOGUL** advertising (in top of the door panel numbers) of the organizer is obligatory and may not be refused by the competitors/entrants.

11.4.3.1 DOOR PANELS

Two front door panels measuring 70 cm wide by 20 cm high including a 1 cm white surround. Each of these panels shall comprise a matt black competition number box which shall always be at the front of the panel. Numerals will be fluorescent yellow (PMS 803), 16 cm high and with a stroke width of 2 cm. The remainder of this door panel shall indicate the Division name and the RCE logo.

Each panel shall be placed horizontally at the leading edge of each front door, with the number at the front. The top of the plate shall be between 12 cm and 15 cm below the lower limit of the window. This space (70 x 12 cm) is reserved for the organizers advertising as mentioned in the supp. regulations of the event.

No signage, other than the colour scheme of the car, shall be placed within 10 cm of these panels.

11.4.3.2 SIDE WINDOWS

On the lower part of the left and right rear side windows of the car, the national flag of the driver and the driver's surname will displayed between 6 cm. and 10 cm. high.

Two numbers for each rear side window which shall be 20 cm high with a stroke width of 25 mm, coloured fluorescent orange (PMS 804), and may be reflective. These numbers shall be placed on the rear side windows in top of the driver surname.

11.4.3.3 FRONT WINDOW

At the top Right side (looking from inside the car) of the front window there shall be a fluorescent orange (PMS 804) 14 cm high competition number on a clear background. This number may be reflective and must be visible from the front at eye high level.

11.4.3.4 ROOF PANEL

One matt white roof panel, 35 cm wide by 35 cm high, to be placed on the roof with the top towards the front of the car. A matt black competition number, 5 cm wide by 28 cm high, will be displayed on this panel.

V. RUNNING OF THE EVENT

14. QUALIFYING

There will be 4 laps in the qualifying Heats.

15. FINALS

There will be 6 laps in the Finals.

The drivers of the Rallycross Challenge Europe Divisons (SuperCars, Super1600 and TouringCars) take off with 8 cars in 3 rows (3-2-3) according to the General Regulation of the Rallycross Challenge Europe 2013.

The drivers of the FIA Zone Championship Division (SuperNational) take off with 6 cars in 3 rows (2-2-2) according to the General Regulations of the FIA Zone Rallycross Championship 2013.

16. GENERAL

16.6 Flag signals

If a black flag is shown in a heat, the driver has to go immediately to the paddock or to the departure place in the middle of track; in a final, he has to go to the Parc Fermé or to the departure place in the middle of track.

VI. PARC FERME - RESULTS - PROTESTS

20. PROTESTS - APPEALS

20.1 All protests will be lodged in accordance with the Code. All protests must be made in writing and handed to the Clerk of the Course or his assistant, or in their absence any of the Stewards of the meeting, together with the sum of \in 500.

If the protest requires the dismantling and re-assembly of different parts of a car, the claimant must make a deposit of maximum € 10000.

20.5 Competitors have the right to appeal, as laid down in Articles 181, 182 and 183 of the Code and also as set out in the Rules of the International Court of Appeal. The amount of the appeal fee is € 1200.

VII. PRIZES AND CUPS

21. PRIZES

The podium ceremony on the circuit will be held immediately after races. The winners of the 1st, 2nd and 3rd prizes must be present, wearing their race overalls. Failure to attend this ceremony and/or the wearing of inappropriate clothing will be penalized by the loss of any monetary award / benefit associated with the corresponding position at the end of the race.

The prize-giving will take place at TBA at 19:30

The prizes will be awarded in Euros for Rallycross Challenge Europe drivers. The prizes will be paid only during prize-giving. These prizes are gross income according Czech law.

VIII. OTHER INFORMATION:

22. FIRE EXTINGUISHERS

Each driver is responsible for ensuring that a single piece extinguisher of min. 5 kg is available within his own team's area inside the paddock.

23. ENVIRONMENTAL POLLUTION

Each driver is requested to ensure that a plastic sheet (minimum dimensions 4 metres by 5) is spread on the ground in the place reserved for his team where work is to be done on his car, in order to prevent any pollution in case of an accidental leak, etc.

24. DRIVERS' LIAISON OFFICER

The Drivers Liaison officer is marked with orange tabard with phone number.

The Drivers' Liaison Officer will present a schedule of their duties, which shall be posted on the official notice board of the event.

25. PADDOCK

- 25.1 Each competitor gets a reserved space that takes over and returned in the same condition, including cleaning. Individual el. connection in the paddock is 2 kW. Fuse protection the switchboard 10A.
- No flags; banners or other advertisement/promotion things which are in conflict with the event or organiser sponsors may be placed in the paddock area.
