Riders must be holder of a valid UEM EC Road Race licence.

11. QUALIFICATION AND STARTING GRID

To qualify for the EC race, a rider must achieve at least a time equal to 110% of the time recorded by the fastest rider of his class and accomplished at least 5 laps as practice.

Any rider who fails to achieve a qualifying time will be permitted to take part in the race provided that in any of the official qualifying practice sessions he has achieved a time at least equal to 110 % of the fastest rider in the same session.

See art RR 03.7.1 PRACTICE RESTRICTIONS of the UEM Road Racing Rules.









Exceptions of this rule may be made with approval of the Jury.

The Official Starting Grid will be published after the Warm Up practice.

Note: Timetables can only be changed, with approval of the UEM Jury.

13. PRIZE-GIVING AND PRIZE MONEY

Prize-giving ceremony will be held immediately after the race at the podium in the Pit lane.

The prize money will be paid by bank transfer on the first business day following the date of the event.

14. ENTRANCE TO THE TRACK AND PIT LANE SPEED

Entrance to the track is via the Parc Ferme besides the Technical Centre. Mechanics and helpers may enter the Pit lane between the Parc Ferme and the time keepers house.

Children under the age of 16 years are not allowed in the Pit lane, except participants. A speed limit of **60 km/h** will be enforced in the pit lane at all times during the event. Each time a rider exceeds the limit during the practice, he will be subject to a fine of **€70,-** In case of an offence during the race, the Ride-Through procedure will be applied. As a general rule, all fines must be paid before the end of the event.

15. PROTESTS

All protests must be made in accordance with the requirements of the UEM Disciplinary and Arbitration Code and be accompanied by a fee of: € 130.

16. FUEL

There is no fuel supply in the paddock.











17. INSURANCE

By endorsing the application form for entry, the FMN of the rider certifies that the rider (or passenger) is insured in accordance with the UEM requirements.

In conformity with Art. 110.1 of the Sporting Code, third party insurance in respect of riders and passengers covering accidents occurring during the event including practices will be the responsibility of the organiser.

This insurance includes a guarantee of 170.000 €.

The organizer disclaims all responsibility for damage to a motorcycle, its accessories and components arising out of an accident, fire or other cases.

18. RENUNCIATION OF ANY RECOURSE AGAINST SPORTING AUTHORITIES

Apart from the requirements of the UEM Sporting Code, riders and passengers by participating, renounce all rights of appeal against the organiser, his representatives or agents by arbitration or before a tribunal or any other manner not foreseen by the UEM Sporting Code for any damages for which they could be liable in consequence of all acts or omissions on the part of the organiser, his officials, representatives or agents in the application of these regulations or contributed to or arising out of their actions.








CIRCUITO DE ALBACETE
