Starting cards are handed out for each lap

separately. At the start the rider receives the card for the first lap.

The starting card for every following lap has to be picked up at the start/finish.

Motorcycles:

All trial motocycles in perfect technical condition can be registered. The motorcycles do not need an official homologation for road services.

All trial tyres of the type "Trial Universal" –

of any manufacturer – may be used. Enduro tyres or motocross tyres are not allowed.

Rider's equipment:

All participants have to wear a helmet in perfect technical condition, adequate motorcycle clothing and knee-high boots. Using gloves is recommended. Use only unbreakable goggles. Full-face visors are not allowed.

Protests:

No protest may be raised against the decisions of the judges of fact.
All protests have to be raised according to the sporting code within 30 minutes after the table of the results is displayed, enclosed by a protest fee of 250,-- € to the clerk of the course.

Scoring:

Scoring will be carried out according to the rules of FIM 052.9. The start will be split into several sections, the sequence of the sections has to be maintained starting with the assigned section.

Tracks:

The trial area is inside a protected landscape, thus the riders have to respect the fauna and flora as well as pedestrians and spectators carefully. The marked tracks between the sections have to be used in the given directions with moderate speed and minimal sound level, they must not be left. Practising on the viewpoint mountain, on dry meadows or private properties (e.g. vineyards) is prohibited and may lead to criminal prosecution for an offender.

Limited Liability

The organizers as well as all organizations responsible for preparing and arranging the event, estate owners and single persons are not liable against the riders for any loss or damage occurring in connection with this event.

The participants know the risk of their sport and ride on their own responsibility. They waive all claims among each other.

Every rider carries the responsibility for damages caused by himself or his vehicle to third persons according to civil and criminal law. Submitting his entry the rider accepts the mentioned conditions.

Declaration of the participant:

I am aware of the risks and dangers of trial sport and accepting these.

In case of injury during the event I declare in terms to accept any medical services, rescue work, transportations to a hospital or ambulance station.

I commit to bear all related costs, if they are not covered by insurance contracts. I and all the insurances having placed a contract with me waive any direct or indirect claims against the organizers, officials, owners of private properties and other riders. Submitting the entry I declare that I am fully aware of the meaning and tentative consequences, I enter this commitment and irrevocably disclaim the right to sue. This limited liability is valid within the limitations of Austrian laws and court decisions.
