Q1. **Opening of Meeting**: Marco Bolzanello welcomed everyone and thanked John Collins and the ACU for their hospitality-

Genearl Information: Marco Bolzonello explained that the situation regarding UEM changing to FIM Europe was still ongoing.

At present, the situation with licences was that riders in European Championships would have to be in possession of a UEM licence and an FIM licence was not valid.

Q2. Minutes of Commission Meeting – Belgrade, Serbia: the minutes were approved.

Q3. Analysis and balance of 2012 European Enduro Championship: Rd 2,3,4

Rd 1 had been discussed and approved in Belgrade

Rd 2: Estonia - Pavol Sas had been Jury President at this event and reported on a very well organised event. There were some problems with some Officials not understanding the Technical Enduro regulations. It was a very good race. There was quite a lot of asphalt road joining the off road sections but there were no problems. The result were produced with no problems and the event was very good.

The results of Rd 2 were approved

Rd 3: Latvia - Heiko Junge had been JP, and in his absence Marco Bolzonello reported it had been a very good event. Excellent Opening Ceremony. There were a few small technical problems which were overcome. There were some very hard sections of the course which were modified. The result service was the same as previous round in Estonia and was excellent.

All agreed that the principle of joining Estonia and Latvia over the two weekends worked really well.

The results of Rd 3 were approved

Rd 4 - Final - Slovakia: Marco Bolzonello was JP and reported on a really excellent event and a super Final. All who were there agreed.

It was also a special mention and congratulations to the Finnish rider Marita Nyquist and her Federation for the "Fair Play" attitude adopted when there was a problem at final MX test on day 3.

The results of Rd 4 were approved.

In conclusion the Commission confirmed it had been a very good European Championship season . Special mention was made in regard the work of Promoter Wolfang Butzner and all agreed the promotional material, vehicle and signage had been excellent.

The results of the 2012 European Enduro Championship were homologated

Q4. UEM Enduro 2013 - Regulations.

Various regulations had been examined in Belgrade and the following were additionally changed:

01.8.4: One Make Teams – would be replaced with a "Trade Team Trophy"

After discussion it was agreed that Teams would still make a pre-inscription and entries as described in above regulation. Teams would consist of 3 riders regardless of classes, categories and machines.

- 01.47.2: This was discussed in Belgrade and it was now confirmed that the title "Disqualification" should apply to this regulation,
- 01.14.1 The sentence and regulation requiring a minimum 5 female participants in any round for the class to be valid was to be removed

Appendix 1 of UEM Rules:

Art1. Confirmed in Belgrade that the 125 4t UEM Cup would not be done.

Art 2: After discussion it was agreed hat the 50cc UEM Enduro Cup would be continued as described in current regulations.

There would be some changes to the section "Standards for Organisers".

To be added: "Any Promoter who has a contract with the UEM for the Championship has the right to name the Special Tests which then must be so named in all literature, Supplementary Regulations, Programmes etc

The Promoter must inform the organiser of all promotional requirements at least 60 days before the event. The organiser must reserve prominent and sufficient space at the event for the UEM Promoter and their equipment and materials.

There was discussion regarding the possibility of holding a presentation immediately after the last rider had finished, but it was decided that this would be very difficult to achieve.

In this section some points from 17 onwards would be renumbered for clarity.

Q6. Analysis of 2012 Bajas:

Poland Rd 2 – Carpathia - Dimitris Athanasoulopoulos represented the UEM at this event. Unfortunately there was an accident in which rider Andrea Brunod was fatally injured. The Commission members expressed their sympathy to the riders family. Consequently Day 2 of event was cancelled.

Marco Bolzonello stated he had received a full report from Dimitris as well as appropriate reports from doctor etc. These were carefully studied at the meeting and discussed.

The results of only Day 1 were approved.

Hungarian Baja: Hannu Hakkala was our representative.

This event was combined with FIM Championship, but Hannu reported that everyone was flexible and it worked well. The track was satisfactory although there were quite long asphalt sections. There were no major accidents. Results were also satisfactory although here had been some problems with GPS reliability.

The results of Rd 3 were approved

Portugal, Sandor Sasvari was our representative: There had been some queries prior to race about Prologue. There were only 5 motorcycles and 3 quads in te UEM Championship. The race and organisation was very good, but there had to e some flexibility in regard distance etc The results service was good, and there was a very good Prize ceremony. Sandor reported that as usual the cars were the main priority in such an event.

There was discussion on fact hat this event had been only one day, and although this had not been ideal it had been necessary to save the Championship.

The results were approved with the recommendation that this event should be of two days duration in accordance UEM Baja regulations.

Q7. 2013 Baja: There was discussion on principle of running UEM Championship events at same time as FIM Championship events. It was agreed that this was possible, but there needed to be careful co-operation in regard regulations etc. If a rider was contesting the UEM Championship, then these rules must apply.

After discussion there were various changes made to the text of the Baja European Championship rules, as proposed in the documentation examined in the meeting. These alterations would be shown in the draft regulations.

2012 Serres Rally: Sandor Sasvari reported that the event was good after organisers corrected some small mistakes. The GPS worked perfectly and was also able to check speeds of riders etc. The Clerk of Course was very efficient and quickly solved any problems. Sandor remarked there were some problems I regard UEM regulations for this type of event, and it was emphasised that the UEM Sporting Code should be used when necessary. The results for the event were a approved.
