PROPOSITIONS 2020

INTRODUCTION

Peugeot Czech Republic, in cooperation with AČR, PIRELLI, GEFCO ČR and other partners, organizes the cup series within the Czech Rally Championship called:

PEUGEOT RALLY CUP CZECH REPUBLIC

(hereinafter PRCCZ)

Approved by ASN as: **AR01220**, from **20. 12. 2019**



Article 1. ORGANIZATION

The organizer of PRCCZ is the company:

PEUGEOT RALLY CUP CZECH REPUBLIC (PRCCZ) is properly listed and registered under the approval number: *(to be completed)*

Article 2. PARTICIPANTS

Participant of the PEUGEOT RALLY CUP CZECH REPUBLIC may be a driver who holds a valid national or international ACR license for 2020, as well as foreign drivers with a valid license for 2020, issued by a national sports body of the European Union.

Precondition for participation is to fill in and submit the application for the PRCCZ series and to pay the deposit.

Article 3. VEHICLES

Only participants with Peugeot 208 R2 can take part in the PEUGEOT RALLY CUP CZECH REPUBLIC series.

It is mandatory that racing cars are equipped with components that are included in the homologation No. A-5743 for Peugeot 208 R2 and sold by Peugeot Sport.

Article 4. CALENDAR OF EVENTS

PEUGEOT RALLY CUP CZECH REPUBLIC will be announced at the following events of the Czech Rally Championship:

Article 5. APPLICATIONS

5.1. APPLICATIONS FOR THE SERIES

Application for the PRCCZ may be submitted at any time during the 2020 season. However, the application becomes effective as of the date of delivery to promoter and payment of the deposit.

By signing the application, the PRCCZ participant accepts all regulations of this provisions and commit to comply with these regulations. At the same time, the participant commits to observe and maintain the spirit of competition and fair play access within the PRCCZ.

Candidates for participation in the PRCCZ may also apply for a one-time application to the selected event or events.

The application for PRCCZ does not replace other registrations and applications for individual enterprises and classifications within ASN Czech Republic.

The PRCCZ organizer and promoter reserve the right to review all applications in order to preserve the sporting spirit of the series and it further reserves the right to refuse or exclude the driver during the season, even without giving reasons.

In case a candidate, a participant driver or a co-driver of the PRCCZ is subject to criminal prosecution or conviction for a crime or other offense for less than the last 10 years, they are obliged to inform the organizer of this fact. Under Article 74 of the International Sporting Code, the organizer reserves the right to refuse an application for the PRCCZ if a driver or a co-driver has been or is subject to criminal prosecution or other disciplinary action that could harm the good reputation of the PRCCZ.

Alongside with the completed and signed application form for the PRCCZ series, participants are obliged to submit the following documents:

- 2 up to date photos - (a driver and a co-driver)

IMPORTANT: Please complete the application form with an email address which the organizer or promoter will consider as a contact and to which all important information will be sent. Furthermore, state the account number to which any financial rewards will be sent to you.

5.2. APPLICATIONS FOR EVENTS

Participants of the PRCCZ series must register for individual events of the Czech Republic Championship in accordance with the valid Sporting Code. A copy of this application must be sent to the PRCCZ promoter no later than the closing date for applications.

Article 6. SERIES DEPOSIT AND ENTRY FEE

The series deposit for PRCCZ 2020 is **20 000 Kč** + corresponding VAT

This amount includes one set of mandatory ads per car, one set of patches for the driver's and co-driver overall, and promotional clothing.

ONE TIME DEPOSIT

Participants wishing to participate only in selected event (s) of the PEUGEOT RALLY CUP CZ series may pay a one-time deposit of this amount:

participation in one event:	5 000 Kč excl. VAT
participation in two events:	10 000 Kč excl. VAT
participation in three events:	10 000 Kč excl. VAT
participation in four events:	15 000 Kč excl. VAT

Participants will pay the deposit to the promoter account number: **2301281407/2010**, message for the recipient will include PRCCZ, a name and a surname of the driver.

Entry fees for individual events are paid directly by the participants to the organizers of individual events according to valid rules of the Czech Rally Championship and special regulations of individual events.

Article 7. ANNOUNCED PRIZE MONIES

Prize monies for total standing will be paid no later than 30. 11.2020.

Article 8. PLATNOST ŘÁDŮ

Participants in PRCCZ are obliged to observe:

- FIA International Sporting Code;
- AČR National Sporting Code;
- FIA Regional Code (Standard Proposition of AČR)
- Special and Implementing provisions of individual events
- Technical regulations for the vehicle
- PRCCZ series proposition



PRCCZ participants are further obliged to respect

- compliance with the instructions of the organizers and the marshals of individual events
- compliance with the instructions of the organizer and the promoter of PRCCZ 2020
- the rights of residents and other road users

Article 9. COMPULSORY ADVERTISING SPACES

PRCCZ participants are aware that the below mentioned advertising spaces serve solely for the needs of the PRCCZ organizer, promoter, and partners.

VEHICLE: see a picture

OVERALL: see a picture

TEAM BACKGROUND: Placing the “fly wing” flag of Peugeot and ACR in the team background for the duration of the event and during each event (to be provided by the promoter).

Signing the application form means that each participant acknowledges that the organizer, promoter, AUTOMOBILES PEUGEOT, PIRELLI, GEFCO and other PRCCZ partners have the right to use the name and voice of the driver, race car and team background photos for any marketing and PR purposes, and do it for indefinitely long period.

All logos on the assigned promotional spaces of the PRCCZ organizer and promoter must be placed throughout the whole event.

If the participants comply with the above-mentioned obligations and valid ACR regulations, they will be allowed to mark their vehicles, overalls and team background with logos of other brands, provided that these companies are not among competing companies of PRCCZ partners and sponsors.

Promotional clothing provided by the promoter must be used by the participants according to promoter 's instructions, but at least at administrative and technical checks, during presentations and promotions.

Article 10. EVENT CLASSIFICATION – POINTS ALLOCATION

Within the PRCCZ, participants will be credited with points for standing in the event according to the following table:

1 st position	25

Barum Czech rally Zlín – coefficient of 1,5multiple of the above mentioned points.

The full number of points is awarded in case of a start of at least five participants in the PRCCZ series. In the case of a smaller number of participants, points will be allocated according to the following table:

INDIVIDUAL STAGE CLASSIFICATION – POINTS ALLOCATION

Within PRCCZ participants will be credited points for standing in a separate evaluation of each stage:

Barum Czech rally Zlín – coefficient of 1,5multiple of the above mentioned points.

The driver with the most points will be the PRCCZ total Winner. All points received in individual PRCCZ events counts for the final ranking.

In case of ex aequo, the final ranking will be determined by the number of better positions in individual stages.

Participants will be awarded points according to valid rules and regulations within the Czech Rally Championship.

Article 9. PUBLIC RELATIONS

Participants of the PRCCZ series are required to spread the good name of the series and observe the following points:

- + driver and co-driver must wear PRCCZ clothing delivered by the organizer during press conferences, shooting interviews, video recordings, official photography, administrative and technical checks, podium and other ceremonial announcements and presentation events (T-shirts, half shirts, caps)
- + when communicating their social activity they must use a link under their posts @peugeotrallycup
- + share photos, videos and posts from FB - Peugeot Rally Cup CZ profile on their private or team profile as much as possible
- + upon request of the promoter provide timely statements for press releases, possibly photos and on-board videos.

Article 10. RULE VIOLATION

The PRCCZ promoter may impose a fine of up to CZK 5 000 for each offense in case of violation of the rules, regulations, technical regulations, implementing and special provisions.

In case of serious or repeated rules violation, the participant may be deprived of points from the total PRCCZ score or exclude from the whole series.

In such a case, the participant is not entitled to refund the deposit for the series.

AUTOKLUB PEUGEOT RALLY TALENT 2020

Article 1. PARTICIPANTS

Within the PRCCZ series is announced as of 2020 a separate classification for driver up to 25 years.

Article 2. CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

Drivers who will be a maximum of 25 years in the 2020 season (they may not reach the age of 26 in 2020), are Czech citizens and hold an ACR license, can apply for the AUTOKLUB PEUGEOT RALLY TALENT 2020 (hereinafter APRT) program.

Article 3. RATING

Drivers included in the **AUTOKLUB** PEUGEOT RALLY TALENT 2020 AUTOKLUB program will be awarded with points in the same way as other participants of the PEUGEOT RALLY CUP CZ series.

The driver who scores in total the most points from all PRCCZ events will be announced as the APRT winner for 2020.

In the case of ex aequo, the ranking will be determined by the number of better positions in individual stages.

Article 4. REWARDS

The APRT 2020 winner will take part in the 208 Cup final race in the 2020 season in France. The PRCCZ promoter will provide contribution on the participation to this event as follows:

CZK 100 000 (this amount will be paid no later than at the start of the event)
paid start fee
one set of tyres for free

PEUGEOT RALLY CUP CZECH REPUBLIC

TECHNICAL REGULATIONS

Article 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

Vehicles of the PEUGEOT RALLY CUP CZECH REPUBLIC series have to meet the conditions and rules of the Technical Regulation according to Appendix J FIA for the 2WD group and Class 6, as well as the parameters given in the technical and homologation sheet number A-5743 for Peugeot 208 R2.

The PRCCZ promoter may, with the approval of the Sporting and Technical Commissioners nominated for each event, conduct technical inspections throughout the event. The PRCCZ promoter may appoint a responsible person for these checks. These checks may verify the technical condition of the vehicle, whether it complies with the technical regulation and the homologation certificate, the use of mandatory tyres, the placement of mandatory organizer advertisements and the cleanliness of the vehicle. Should the car be subject to a technical inspection at the order of the director of the event or the steward, it will be carried out by the delegated technical stewards of the event.

In case of doubt about the conformity of any mechanical part, the manufacturer's technical manual or the same new part will serve as a reference.

Article 2. REPLACEMENT OF PARTS, INTERVENTIONS? ON THE VEHICLE

Worn down mechanical parts must be replaced exclusively:

- by the same original part as listed in the PEUGEOT / PEUGEOT SPORT parts list.
- by the original part from a spare parts distributor for PEUGEOT SPORT race events.
- by the special part listed in the list of one of PEUGEOT SPORT technical partners.

All interventions on the vehicle relating to the structure of the vehicle, bodywork, mechanical parts, electrical parts and equipment may only be carried out using the method specified by AUTOMOBILES PEUGEOT and the technical documentation PEUGEOT SPORT 2016/2017/2018/2019 208R2 available on:

Additions to the technical installation instructions in the form of "Info-Tech" may be published during the season to help resolve individual technical problems that might arise.

Article 3. TYRES, RIMS

3.1 TYRES

Each car competing in the PRCCZ must be equipped with PIRELLI tyres distributed by the company:

3.2. RIMS

Vehicles of the PRCCZ 2020 series can only use 6.5 x 16" rims for tarmac or 6" x 15" rims for gravel, from the PEUGEOT 208 R2 kit, distributed by PEUGEOT SPORT or its official distributors.

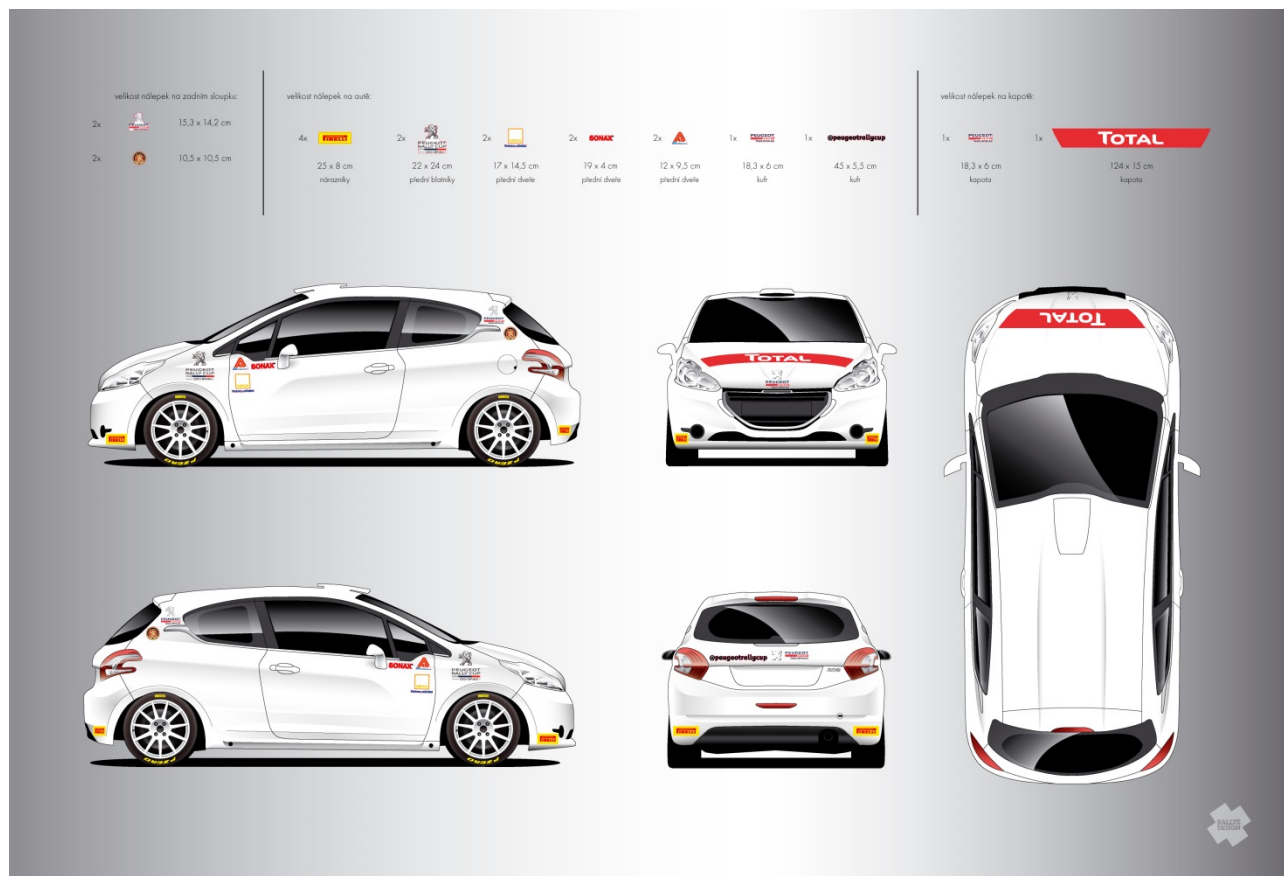
