Art. 1.1 Preamble

Entries must be submitted in accordance with the FIA RRSR Art. 22– Art. 25. See also FIA ISC Art. 3.8 – Art. 3.14

Entry is made only in electronic form at www.agrotecrally.cz. An electronic entry application must be confirmed by way of personal signature by the competitor by the latest at administrative checks.

The entry form must be accompanied by a copy of the valid competitor's licence.

A change of competitor is permitted up to the close of entries.

Only the competitor entered in the event will be allowed to make this request.

All competitors taking part in a Championship event must ensure that their drivers and co-drivers sign the *Driver's Declarations and Undertakings* form as attached in RRSR Appendix XIV.

This form is available at <u>https://www.fia.com/regulation/category/117</u> (RELATED DOCUMENTS section). Please print, fill in and sign the Driver's Declaration.

The completed and signed Driver's Declaration must be handed to the organiser at the Administrative checks.

Foreign competitors, drivers and co-drivers must present authorisation from their ASN (according to Art. 3.9.4 of the Code).

Applications will be confirmed by email.

An entry application (also made electronically) will be accepted only if accompanied by the total entry fees. According to the International Sporting Code Art. 3.8.1 an entry compels the competitor to take part in the Competition in which they have been accepted to run, except in case of duly established Force Majeure.

4.3.3.4 Organiser's cup

Eligible cars: Cars with national homologation (ASN homologation) or cars with valid or expired FIA homologation (FIA homologation since 1.1.1975), for which the company is not listed in the RS, can participate in the Organiser's cup. Cars without national or FIA homologation are not allowed.

The safety equipment of the crew, the safety equipment of the car and the minimum prescribed weight must comply with the valid technical regulations of the Czech Championship.

Obligation of the competitor for a car with foreign national homologation or for a car with FIA homologation modified according to the national regulations is to provide to the organiser the national homologation of the car and the technical regulations according to which the car is to compete in the foreign championship at least 14 days before the entry deadline. Both documents will be immediately forwarded by the organiser to the Chief Scrutineer for verification. The Chief Scrutineer has the right to refuse the approval of the application.

Art. 4.5 Payment

Art. 4.6 Entry fee refunds

The entry fee will be refunded in full:

- if the application is rejected,
- If the rally is cancelled,
- if the entry is cancelled before the deadline,
- for reasons of force majeure

Partial refund of the entry fee:

- Crews who duly excuse their non-participation before the start of the reconnaissance will be refunded at least 80% of their deposit.
- Crews excusing themselves before the start of the administrative checks period will be refunded 50% of their deposit.

Art. 5. Insurance Cover

- Art. 5.1.1 The organiser has concluded an insurance contract with Allianz pojišťovna, a.s.
- Art. 5.1.2 The part of the insurance agreement is the coverage for cars against the damage caused to third party up to EUR 2 000 000 per incident. However, the damage caused by drivers among themselves is not covered by this contract.

The organizer binds self to arrange this insurance contract for all competitors except those, who will show the long-term liability insurance covering damages caused on closed route.

- Art. 5.1.3 The insurance for organizers and participants is made with an integral excess of CZK 5 000. It means that damage up to CZK 5 000 won't be refunded and damage over CZK 5 000 will be covered without the complicity of insured.
- Art. 5.1.4 All crews at administrative check have to hand in the valid International Green Card for their car. Without this card the crew won't be permitted to start.

5.2 Insurance Coverage for the competitors and crews

All the drivers and co-drivers are obliged to arrange their own accident insurance. The proof should be documented on request at administrative check. The insurance of foreign crews has to cover the costs of possible medical treatment in the Czech Republic. Insurance cover must start from Shakedown until Parc Fermé after the finish of the rally.

5.3 Damage Reporting

The crews are obliged to notify the organizer about the damage caused on the track by their car by the end of event the latest. Violation of this duty stands for summoning the competitor and involved crew to a Stewards.

5.4 Insurance Coverage Exclusions

Auxiliary vehicles, cars dedicated to reconnaissance use and vehicles with special labels issued by the organiser is not covered by the provided rally insurance (with the exception of insured organiser's cars) and those are always going on their own responsibility.

Art. 6. Advertising and Identification

See Appendix 4 of these SR "Decals and positioning of supplementary advertising".

The organiser will provide each crew with the number identification (67x17cm), which must be affixed to their car in the stated positions prior to scrutineering. Each panel shall be placed horizontally at the leading edge of each front door, with the number at the front. The top of the plate shall be between 7 cm and 10 cm below the lower limit of the window. It is not allowed to cut the panel.

ERT Eligible vehicles

A space measuring 67 x 6 cm, located immediately below the competition number panel, is reserved for the promotion of the FIA European Rally Trophy.

The following sticker shall be affixed at this space:



MCR and RCH Eligible vehicles

Front window (advertising of Promoter Czech Championship): will be announced in a bulletin A strip 10 cm high and running the full width of the windscreen below the existing 10 cm high reserved for competitors at the top of the windscreen.

Art. 6.2 Optional organiser's advertising

Spaces on the vehicle that must be kept free:

Organiser reserves following places which must remain free: place 67 x 20 cm under starting numbers on both sides of front doors for ERT, and MČR, RCH and Organizer's cup cars and rectangle place width 50 cm and height 14 cm on both front doors over starting numbers or 2 x 7 cm over and under starting number by Art. 4.3.2.3 National cars - Historical rally.

Placement of advertisings proposed by organiser is given in Appendix 4 of these supplementary regulations.

Art. 7. Tyres

Art. 7.1 Regulations regarding tyres which may be used during the rally

See Art. 13 of the FIA RRSR (TYRES AND WHEELS).

The Quantity of tires are not limited.

The hand cutting is permitted but must be in accordance with the patterns submitted by the tyre manufacturer to the FIA.

Art. 7.2 Tyres for use on reconnaissance

At all times during the event in the Czech Republic, the tread depth of the tyres fitted on the car, must not be less than 1.6 mm.

Art. 7.3 National laws or special requirements

For Czech Rally Championship the tyres have to meet ACCR regulations 2024, see Art. 13. In Czech National Championship 2024 (cars in art. 4.3.3.1, 4.3.32 and 4.3.2.7 SR) tyres according to FIA 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2022 and 2024 are allowed.

Hand cutting is allowed.

In Autoklub Czech Historic Sporting Rally Championship (cars in art 4.3.3.3 SR) tyres with EHK, DOT or FIA homologation can be used. Size has to be in comply with art. 8, appendix K of FIA International Sporting Code (tolerance maximum minus 3 %).

Art. 8. Fuel

All type of fuel must follow Appendix J Art. 252.9. (RRSR Art. 62). Unleaded fuel with maximum lead content of 0.013 g/l permitted.

Art. 8.1 Refuelling

Art. 8.1.1 Refuelling is only allowed in Refuelling Area (RA) and commercial fuel station. To refuel in the service park is forbidden at any time.

Art. 8.1.2 To access a Refuelling Area, all personnel involved in refuelling operations must wear clothing that provides adequate protection against fire and includes at least: long trousers, long-sleeved top, closed shoes, gloves and a balaclava.

Art. 8.1.3 Environmental Mat in a Refuelling Area (RA)

The organiser will protect the ground with an Environmental Mat.

Art. 9. Reconnaissance of Special Stages

Reconnaissance will be according to FIA RRSR Art. 35. The schedule for the reconnaissance is published in Appendix 2 of these supplementary regulations.

Art. 9.1 Registration procedure

Recce cars must be registered with a separate form.

Each car must be identified with a reconnaissance car number supplied by the organiser. Rally cars used in the event may not be used for reconnaissance.

During issuing of the road book each crew announces to the organiser the make and the registration number of the car which the crew will use for reconnaissance. Changes must be reported to the phone + 420 775 760 464. The crew shall receive reconnaissance car stickers. Identification sticker must be affixed in right upper part of the windscreen and on the rear side windows until the finish of reconnaissance.

Art. 9.2 Specific regulations

During reconnaissance, all national traffic regulation must be followed, including but not limited to the speed limits. Please note that the Special Stages will not be closed to public traffic during reconnaissance. The organizer may reduce the allowed speed individually by marking the areas in the road book and along the route.

- Art. 9.2.1 Reconnaissance programme is published in Appendix No. 2. Crews must comply with FIA regional regulations and this SR about reconnaissance. Vehicles specified in art. 35.1 FIA regional regulations can only be used. These vehicles must have valid insurance.
- Art. 9.2.2 As from the publication of the rally Supplementary Regulations, any driver, or his co-driver, or any other team member who has entered or intends to enter a Championship rally and who wishes to drive on any road which is used as a special stage in that rally, may only do so after he has obtained the organiser's written permission. Failure to respect this rule shall result in the driver being reported to the Stewards.
- Art. 9.2.3 After issuing of the supplementary regulations the person connected with crew can move on the rally track (with exception for walking) only with expressed agreement from the Clerk of the Course. Clerk of the Course will not allow crew to start in the competition in case of branch of this regulation.
- Art. 9.2.4 Driving in opposite direction is strictly prohibited with exceptions of the instructions given in the road book and parts of stages as described in appendix No. 2 of this supplementary regulations.
- Art. 9.2.5 Failure to comply with the traffic regulations (especially speed limit) will be checked via GPS tracking system and punished by Police of the Czech Republic in standard way. This doesn't preclude further sanctions on the crew according to FIA RRSR Article 34.2.
- Art. 9.2.6 If the crew will not have working GPS in their recce car during reconnaissance, this will be considered as break of rules and will be reported to the Stewards.

Art. 9.3 Number of Passages

The maximum number of passages authorised for each crew on each special stage is three.

Art. 9.4 Collection of speed control checking devices

All reconnaissance cars must be equipped with a speed control checking device. This device can be collected according to the programme in chronological order (SR Art. 3). The crews are obliged to follow all reconnaissance rules specified in FIA Regional Sporting Regulations and these Supplementary Regulations. Not respecting these rules, especially exceeding the speed limits, will be monitored via ONI® tracking system. This checking doesn't exclude other checks, i.e. police controls according to their standard procedures.

Art. 10. Administrative checks

Art. 10.1 Documents to be presented:

To keep the time required for the administrative checks to the necessary minimum, make sure to bring and present the following documents:

- Competitors' licence
- Driver's and co-driver's competition licences
- Driver's and co-driver's ID cards/passports
- Driver's and co-driver's valid driving licences
- Driver's and co-driver's signed *Driver's declaration and undertakings* forms
- ASN authorisation for foreign competitors (if required)
- Completion of all details on the entry form
- Car insurance cover certificate
- Car registration papers
- The consent of the owner of the vehicle, unless he is one of the crew members

Art. 10.2 Timetable

See programme (SR Art. 3)

Art. 11. Scrutineering, Sealing and Marking

Art. 11.1 Scrutineering, venue and time

Cars may be presented at scrutineering by a representative of the team. See programme (SR Art. 3)

Art. 11.1.1 Scrutineering, mandatory documents

- Cars' complete certified homologation
- SOS / OK board (DIN A3 format)
- Technical card and filled drivers' safety equipment card
- Other documents prescribed by technical regulations.

For each car of the **FIA Priority Drivers**, one spare gearbox and one set of spare differentials (front and/or centre and/or rear) may be used in each rally. These spare components and those fitted to the car will be marked/sealed at initial scrutineering. These cars must have their sump guards removed for sealing of gearboxes and differentials and be kept with the car for the purpose of weighting.

The installation of the tracking system will be checked at scrutineering.

Art. 11.1.2 Timetable for scrutineering

See programme (SR Art. 3)

Detailed schedule will be published on DNB.

Art. 11.2 Mud flaps

It is **optional** to fit transverse mud flaps in conformity with the article Appendix J, Art. 252.7.7

Art. 11.3 Windows

Use of tinted windows is not authorized in accordance with Article 253.11 "Windows/nets" of Appendix J of the FIA International Sporting Code.

Art. 11.4 Drivers' safety equipment

All items of clothing including helmets and FHR (Front Head Restraint) intended to be used, e.g. HANS devices, must be presented for scrutineering. They shall be checked for compliance with Appendix L, Chapter III.

Art. 11.5 Noise level

All cars must be equipped with stable exhaust silencer. The outside noise level measured by stationary method may not exceed 96 dB/A for all cars with the margin of error plus 2 dB/A. The noise level will be measured at 3500 revs/min in petrol engine cars and at 2500 revs/min in diesel engine cars - according to EHK Regulations 49.02. Allowed noise level of historical cars for Czech rally competitions is 96(A) + 2 dB(A) - according to appendix K of International Sporting Code.

Noise level will be measured during scrutineering and eventually at any point during the rally. Any exceeding of noise limit during scrutineering results in start refusal, any exceeding of noise limit in the course of the rally will be reported to the Stewards.

Art. 11.6 Special national requirements

All vehicles according to Art. 4.3.3 SR have to comply with Czech law No. 56/2001 Sb. (Act on the Conditions of Vehicle Operation on Roads) with exceptions for sporting vehicles.

Art. 11.7 Installation of the safety tracking system

Art. 11.7.1 All competitors must make provisions in their rally cars for the installation of the FIA Safety Emergency Console System, and the system must be installed before the car is brought to scrutineering. The name of FIA official supplier for ERT will be publish by a Bulletin.

All rally participants in the Czech Republic national cars (cars in art. 4.3.3.2, 4.3.3.3. 4.3.3.4) will get their cars equipped with GPS monitoring devices:

ONI[®] monitoring devices including two antennas, monitoring unit and red flag alarm diode.

Art. 11.7.2 After arrival to the scrutineering, device administrator will install the tracking unit, antenna and control panel to the vehicle prior to passing the scrutineering.

Art. 11.7.3 After the installation, the device administrator checks the mounting of the holder, installs the monitoring unit and tests the system using a "Dallas" chip. To install the GPS rental kit, it is necessary to prepare a 12V power outlet.

Eventual destruction, non-return or damage of the unit has to be paid for by the competitor to the provider in accordance with the applicable price list. Every attempt to falsify, manipulate or infringe the tracking device, which will make impossible to collect data because of external interference will be reported to the Stewards who can penalize the crew up to disqualification from the event.

Art. 12. Other procedures and regulations

Art. 12.1 Ceremonial start procedures and order

There will be no Ceremonial Start.

Art 12.1.1 Rally start – 1st section Leg 1

The official start of the rally will take place at the TC 0 (Service - Out). The starting order list for Section 1 will be published on the Digital Notice Board.

Art. 12.2 Start procedure on Special Stages (Electronic start procedure)

The electronic start procedure is as follows:

The start for SS will be performed by an electronic hand or digital countdown system clearly visible to the crew from the start position. The photocell is located at 50 cm behind the starting line at a height of 0.5 m (+5 cm).

The position of the vehicle at the start must be with the front of the vehicle on the level of the starting line.

Timekeeper returns the time card back to the crew as soon as possible.

Light signals combined with digital countdown system will be used:

40 seconds - red light switches on

30 seconds – the starter shows on starting countdown system

10 seconds – red light blinks on

START – green light switches on

-20 seconds – green light switches off and red light switches on and art. 48.4.3 of the FIA regional regulations will be applied.

Art. 12.3 Finish procedure

Art. 12.3.1 There will be a specific finish procedure

Rally finish - TC 12C located at entry to parking place before finish ramp. Podium will be prepared for first three crews in the general classification of ERT, MČR, RCH. Prizes described in art. 14 SR will be given on podium during ceremonial prize giving. Crews must continue directly to Parc Fermé after finish ceremony.

Art. 12.3.2 Availability of participants

Participants who park their vehicles in the Parc Fermé upon passing the finish line, must remain available by phone (mobile) until the final classification has been posted.

Art. 12.3.3 Classification

The final classification will not be distributed after the event. The final classification will be published on the Digital Notice Board.

Art. 12.4 Permitted early check-in

Early entry to the TC 6A, 12C and 12D is permitted without penalty.

Art. 12.5 Super Special Stage, regulations, and order

There will be no Super Special Stage.

Art. 12.6 Special procedures and activities

Art. 12.6.1 Shakedown

Registration for shakedown should be confirmed in entry form and is charged with CZK 2200 / EUR 88 for each car. Charge should be paid with entry fee. Participation on shakedown is only allowed to registered crews. All security rules for SS are also valid for shakedown. There is no limit in number of passes.

During Shakedown service is only permitted in the main service park. Any break of this rule will be penalized with penalty CZK 5000 / EUR 200.

Art. 12.6.2 Tyre Warming Zone (TWZ)

There will be no Tyre Warming Zones according to Art. 44.4 of the RRSR.

Art. 12.6.3 Service Park organisation

For FIA and ASN drivers will be allocated approx. 100 m^2 , for other drivers 80 m^2 . Allocated place will be announced during entrance to the service area Other requests:

Solving the requirement for location of service place is not guaranteed by the organizer.

Other services requests for larger service (max 120 m^2) or other requests must be sent to the organizer till closing date for entries.

Car identified as "SERVIS" (service), "DOPROVOD" (auxiliary) and "SEZNAMOVACÍ VOZIDLO" (recce car) are allowed to enter the service area. All competitors must use only actually valid stickers.

Extra requests applied after closing date for entries and secured by the organizer are additionally charged by fee CZK 2500 / EUR 100 excl. VAT.

Service Park regulations:

During the service time between the first rally car enters and the last car leaves the service park, it is strictly forbidden for all service vehicles to enter or drive inside the service park (not valid in case of transportation broken cars). Every infringement will be sanctioned by the Clerk of the Course with penalty of EUR 80. Service park traffic is one-way only - for rally cars as well as the service and auxiliary vehicles. Maximum speed inside the service park is limited to 30 km/h.

It is strictly forbidden smoking and handling open flames in the service Park!!!

Team vehicles may only park in the service area on allocated place /not on the pavements/. If anyone will not follow this rule, affected car will be towed away and penalty (fine) EUR 400 will be applied by the Clerk of the Course.


Trailers for transportation rally cars must be parked on the reserved area (Hustopeče, AGROTEC a.s., Brněnská 74 - N 48°56.95855', E 16°43.73417'), penalty (fine) of EUR 200 will be applied by the Clerk of the Course in case of braking this regulation.

Art. 12.6.4 Chicanes (Barriers)

Chicanes will be installed on the Special Stages due to safety reasons. Judges of the fact list will be published on the official notice board. Incorrect barrier passing will be penalised by the Clerk of the Course as follow:

• moving or rollover at least one part of the chicane off the base or moving more parts or missing (omission) the retarder 30 sec.

Art. 15. Final checks / Protests / Appeals

Art. 15.1 Final Checks

Time and location: see programme (SR. Art. 3)

Any teams required to undergo final scrutineering must immediately follow the instruction of the marshals in charge, even if this prevents them from proceeding to one or more time controls (TC). The complete original FIA homologation form and other necessary certifications must be available for final scrutineering. A representative of the competitor as well as mechanics with the appropriate tools (in case of dismantling) must be present at the final scrutineering.

Art. 15.2 Protest or petition for review deposit

The protest or petition for review deposit is:

EUR 1.000 (to be paid in cash or by bank transfer)

If the deposit is made by bank transfer, the protest or petition for review must be accompanied by proof of payment. Failing this, or should the Stewards consider that the proof of payment is not satisfactory, the protest or petition for review shall not be admissible.

If a protest requires the dismantling and re-assembly of a clearly defined part of the car, any additional deposit will be specified by the Stewards upon a proposal of the Chief Scrutineer.

Art. 15.3 Appeal deposit

The appeal deposit for an international appeal is: EUR 3.000,00

All protests and/or appeals must be lodged in accordance with Articles 13 and 15 of the Code and, where applicable, with the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules.

Art. 15.4 Fines

In accordance with Article 12.8 FIA International Sporting Code, the payment of the fines must be done online, within 48 hours of their notification, at the following address: <u>https://fiafines.fia.com</u>

Any delay in making payment may entail Suspension during the period a fine remains unpaid.







Each panel shall be placed horizontally at the leading edge of each front door, with the number at the front. The top of the plate shall be between 7 cm and 10 cm below the lower limit of the window. It is not allowed to cut the panel.

Appendix 5 – Extracts from FIA ISC Appendix L relating to overalls, helmets and any other safety requirements

All competitors are reminded of Appendix L of the FIA International Sporting Code, in particular its Chapter III - Drivers' Equipment.

Helmets (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 1)

All crews must wear crash helmets homologated to one of the FIA standards listed in Appendix L.

Frontal Head Restraint (FHR, Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 3)

All crews must use FIA approved FHR systems homologated to FIA standard 8858. Approved FHRs, anchorages and tethers are listed in Technical List N° 29. See also helmet compatibility chart in Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 3.3.

Flame-resistant clothing (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 2)

All drivers and co-drivers must wear overalls as well as gloves (optional for co-drivers), long underwear, a balaclava, socks and shoes homologated to the FIA 8856-2000 standard (Technical List N°27) or to the FIA 8856-2018 (Technical List N° 74). Please pay special attention to the prescriptions of Art. 2 <u>concerning the correct wearing of the clothing elements! See also FIA Regional Rally Sporting Regulations Article 53.1.</u>

Any FIA-approved 8856-2018 garment customised using printing or transfers must be accompanied by a certificate from the manufacturer.

FIA Priority drivers (and accompanying co-drivers) must wear overalls as well as gloves (optional for codrivers), long underwear, a balaclava, socks and shoes homologated to the FIA 8856-2018 standard (Technical List No 74).

Biometric Devices (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 2.1)

Drivers may wear a device to collect biometric data during racing.

- If the biometric device is integrated into a protective garment homologated to FIA Standard 8856, the garment shall be homologated to FIA Standards 8856 and 8868-2018.
- If the biometric device is a stand-alone device, then the device must be homologated to FIA Standard 8868-2018 only. This device must be worn in addition to the garment homologated to FIA Standard 8856.

Wearing of jewellery (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 5)

The wearing of any type of jewellery, such as but not limited to, neck chains, bracelets or watches is prohibited during the competition. Exceptions to this rule, providing the CMO and/or Medical Delegate do not consider that due to size or location they may delay rescue or hinder emergency care, are:

- i. the wearing of watch(es) by co-drivers, on the condition that the watch(es) is worn over the overall,
- ii. the wearing of a single band-style ring providing it does not restrict the natural range of motion of the hand, and
- iii. the wearing of body piercing(s) providing they are not worn in and/or around the oral cavity.

Appendix 6 – Tracking system

FIA Safety Emergency Console System

The name of FIA official supplier for ERT will be publish by a Bulletin.

ONI[®] tracking system for reconnaissance – backup GPS tracking system will be used ONI[®]

1. General provisions

During the rally, all competition vehicles must be equipped with monitoring ONI® system. The ONI® monitoring equipment is the property of the Autoclub of the Czech Republic and the competitors must loaned to the competitors for a one-time fee of 150 CZK per unit (included in the entry deposit), or 500 CZK for the whole set (paid by the competitor), if he has not purchased the basic installation kit earlier. The price of the permanent installation set is 1260 CZK.

Any destruction, non-return or damage to the equipment must be paid by the competitor to the administrator according to the approved price list. Failure to return the unit immediately after the competition will result in the crew will be fined 3000 CZK. Until the unit is returned, the crew will not be allowed to start the next competition.

2. Distribution of the ONI[®] tracking system

ONI® tracking system contains following parts:

- tracking unit with display
- tracking unit holder
- power supply cable
- combined antenna roof
- control panel containing:
 - OK button to cancel the alarm / confirm red flag
 - SOS switch for calling emergency

finish, in front of the finish ramp or in a closed car park.



ONI[®] tracking system will be installed to every rally car before each event. Detailed information will be published no later than during roadbook issuing.

After arrival to the scrutineering, device administrator will install the tracking unit, antenna and control panel. Antenna and power supply cables can be purchased by the crew for personal ownership. At the end of the rally or after retirement, the tracking unit or complete tracking system must be returned to the device administrator. The collection of units usually takes place in the service area before the rally

3. Installation of the unit in the car

3.1 To fit the tracking unit with display, antenna and control panel, it is necessary for the competitor to follow exactly the Installation guide, to keep the unit in good condition and to protect it against damage and fouling (especially the connectors) during the time.

3.2 Foreign and one time rally participants will receive a rental version of the set equipped with magnetic roof antenna.

3.3 Control panel with OK button and SOS switch is in one box for which the competitor has to choose a suitable place for fitting within the reach of both crew members. It is obliged to prepare everything for its installation prior to the scrutineering.

4. The unit operation during rally

To operate the unit, the crews have to meet all instructions as mentioned in the User's guide.

Operation during events on SS:

Accident (crash detection)

- The unit evaluates the situation and sends info about accident to rally control. Crew cannot affect this message.

- The display shows message: Are you OK? Confirm.
- 10 s after this question, the siren wails for next 15 s

- If the crew pushes **OK** button, this information is sent to rally control and information about accident is not sent to the unit of following cars in the stage.

Stop in SS

- When the car stops in SS, it is counted as an obstacle. Unit signals to the crew by sound siren and text, that they have stopped. This signal takes 15 s.

- If the crew doesn't push OK, warning message is sent to the rally control and also to other cars, which are currently in the stage arriving to the obstacle.

- With pushing the OK button the crew confirms that they are okay, on the display is shown message OK and information about obstacle is not send to the unit of next cars in the stage.

Request for help

- Changing the switch is confirmed by SOS message on display, also the siren sounds.
- The siren sound can be cancelled by pushing OK button.

Red flag

- When the rally control hangs out the red flag, the display shows big message RED FLAG (with red background) and the siren sounds.

- Crew has obligation to confirm receiving the red flag by pushing the OK button and to reduce the

- speed according to the sporting regulations.
- The siren sound can be cancelled by pushing OK button.
- The red flag on display can be cancelled only by rally control.

5. Speed checking during reconnaissance

During reconnaissance the crew is obliged to follow traffic rules of the Czech Republic. Not respecting this rule, especially exceeding the speed limits, will be monitored via ONI[®] tracking system. This checking doesn't exclude other checks, i.e. police controls according to their standard procedures.

ONI® tracking system for reconnaissance

Tracking system is checking the speed in every moment during the reconnaissance.

Every crew will pick up the ONI[®] recce tracking unit together with roadbook. Installation of the unit and its using during reconnaissance is obligatory for all crews during the whole schedule of reconnaissance according to the art. 3 Reconnaissance schedule. For speed checking during the reconnaissance, NCL 21 units are used.



NCL21 unit is started during roadbook issuing before starting of reconnaissance. For whole reconnaissance the unit is working on its own battery. It is not necessary to plug the unit to any power supply.

It is possible to place the unit on metal surfaces - magnets are implemented in the unit.

Not using the unit in a rally car during reconnaissance will be fined.

Every attempt to falsify, manipulate or infringe the unit for reconnaissance or any device, which will make impossible to collect data because of external interference will be reported to the stewards who can penalize the crew up to refusing the start.

Decision regarding seriousness of the offence and its repeating is in Clerk of the Course's authority. For exceeding the speed limit, sanctions can be given according to supplementary regulations or championship regulations.
